



### 771 killed in road accidents in 2013

Bangalore traffic police collect Rs. 56.98 crore in fines

Compared to other metro cities the

growth rate of vehicles is five times

higher than the population growth,

BANGALORE: In 2013, 771 people were killed and 4,289 injured in 5,230 cases of road accidents.

Though the traffic police claimed there are fewer cases than last year, the number of deaths recorded is more when compared to figures from the previous two years — 760 in 2012 and 762 in 2011, according to the statistics released by the traffic police on Thursday.


#### 54.32 lakh cases

City Police Commissioner Raghavendra H. Auradkar said the city police booked 54.32 lakh cases of traffic violations in 2013, and collected Ba, 56.98 crore in fines.

A total of 8.22 lakh cases were booked against motor-cyclists riding without a helmet and 1.28 lakh cases hooked for using mobile while driving. Similarly 4.21 lakh cases were booked against those who jumped signals, 85,445 cases for driving without valid documents, 68,365 for rash and negligent driving and 61,709 cases for drunk driving.
