

Workshop highlights

- 1.Demonstration of POP-Q
- 2.Accurate method of dissection and identification of pelvic avascular spaces, fascia, fascial defects like paravaginal defects, pelvic support structures, course of ureter and uterine vessels as seen from vaginal route.
- Art of Non-descent Vaginal Hysterectomy (NDVH) and McCall's culdoplasty.

Proposed Surgeries

- VH with Sacrospinous fixation (SSF) for stage 3 and 4 POP
- VH with High Uterosacral ligament suspension for stage 3/4 POP
- 3. SSF for vaginal vault prolapse
- Abdominal sacrohysteropexy for nulliparous prolapse
- 5. Abdominal sacrocolpopexy for vault prolapse
- Transobturator Tape for SUI proper technique to avoid complications
- Bursch colposuspension and abdominal paravaginal repair for a case of recurrent SUI.
- 8. Pubo-vaginal sling surgery for a case of failed TOT/TVT
- Intravesical Botulinum therapy for refractory
 Overactive bladder
- 10.Vesico-vaginal fistula /Recto-vaginal fistula/ Complete perineal tear repair
