




E. What degree program are you pursuing now 217 responses





F. What subject area are you currently pursuing 217 responses




1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 217 responses









4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 217 responses




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 217 responses


























